Explanation of RAD and DAP

- Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable deposit (RAD), a daily payment (DAP), or a combination of both.
- A refundable deposit (RAD) is paid as a lump sum amount. A daily payment accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes both the partial lump sum (RAD) and a daily payment (DAP).
- A resident with assets less than \$63,000 at time of entry who is deemed to be a government supported resident is not required to pay a RAD or DAP. Asset Threshold Cap – Residential care means test, First asset threshold \$210,555.20, Second asset threshold \$252,000.00, third asset threshold \$355,366.66 and fourth asset threshold \$532,055.20.
